Nepal Swimming Association (NSA)

Policy on Transparent, Merit-Based, and Public Selection Procedures for Athletes and Coaches

Effective From: 2025-08-25

Approved By: NSA Executive Board

Version: 1.0

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that the selection of athletes and coaches representing Nepal in international swimming events is conducted in a **transparent**, **fair**, **merit-based**, **and publicly accessible** manner. This document establishes clear procedures, responsibilities, criteria, and communication mechanisms to uphold integrity, accountability, and equal opportunity within the Nepal Swimming Association (NSA).

2. Scope

This policy applies to:

- All athletes registered with the NSA
- All coaches certified or recognized by the NSA
- All NSA selection committees, officials, and technical personnel
- All international competitions sanctioned by World Aquatics, Asia Aquatics, South Asian Games,
 Olympic Council of Asia, and other officially recognized bodies

3. Guiding Principles

- 1. **Meritocracy:** Selection based strictly on performance, preparedness, and potential.
- 2. **Transparency:** Processes, criteria, and outcomes must be accessible to the public.
- 3. **Equal Opportunity:** No discrimination based on gender, ethnicity, region, religion, or personal affiliation.
- 4. Accountability: Decisions must be evidence-based, documented, and reviewable.
- 5. Integrity: Avoidance of conflict of interest; ethical behaviour required from all officials.

4. Selection Committee

4.1 Composition

The NSA Executive Committee shall appoint a **Selection Committee** comprising:

- 1 Chairperson
- 2 Technical Experts (World Aquatics certified officials preferred)
- 1 Athlete Representative
- 1 Coach Representative
- 1 Independent Observer (without voting rights)

4.2 Eligibility & Conflict of Interest

- Members must declare any conflict of interest in writing.
- Individuals with family or coaching ties to any candidate must recuse themselves.
- All meetings' minutes and decisions must be documented and archived.

5. Selection of Athletes

5.1 Eligibility Requirements

- Must hold valid NSA registration and be in good standing.
- Must hold a Nepalese Passport valid for at least 6 months beyond the competition date.
- Must meet the NSA Code of Conduct and anti-doping compliance requirements.
- Athletes Converting to Nepalese Passport must comply with Sports Nationality Rules & Regulation as per World Aquatics and International Olympic Council.

5.2 Performance-Based Criteria

Selection shall prioritize objective performance indicators such as:

- 1. National Championship Results (within last 3 months or as per NSA if Less than before 3 months)
- 2. World Aquatics Points
- 3. Recognized Time Trials approved by NSA
- 4. International Performance Records (Only When Explicitly mentioned by NSA for Specific Event)
- 5. Recent Form & Consistency—verified through monitored training logs and trial events

Minimum qualifying times (MQTs) shall be published at least **60 days** before selection as mentioned by NSA if the qualifying time period is shorter than 60 days.

5.3 Trials & Evaluation Procedures

- NSA shall organize open, publicly announced trials whenever necessary.
- Results must be recorded electronically and verified by certified officials.
- Documentation of trials must be archived for transparency.

5.4 Final Athlete Selection Process

- 1. Compilation of performance data by NSA technical committee
- 2. Evaluation by the Selection Committee
- 3. Draft list created and signed by all committee members
- 4. Publication of results on the NSA website and public notice board
- 5. Opportunity for appeals

6. Selection of Coaches

6.1 Eligibility

- Must hold valid certification from National Sports Council, World Aquatics, NSA, or equivalent authority
- Must have coached athletes achieving qualifying standards within last 12 months
- Must complete safeguarding, anti-doping, and ethics training

6.2 Selection Criteria

- 1. Track Record: Performance history of coached athletes
- 2. **Technical Expertise:** Certifications, clinic participation, and specialization
- 3. Conduct: Compliance with NSA ethical guidelines
- 4. Communication & Team Management Skills
- 5. Gender Balance: NSA encourages inclusion of qualified women coaches

6.3 Appointment Procedure

- Open call for applications
- Evaluation and scoring using standardized criteria
- Interviews (if required)
- Publication of final list

7. Transparency & Public Disclosure

NSA shall publicly release:

- Selection criteria documents
- Trial dates, venues, and rules
- Athlete performance data (summary format)
- Final selection lists
- Names of Selection Committee members
- Rationale for selection decisions (aggregate explanation)

All information must be uploaded to:

- NSA official website
- NSA social media channels
- Physical notice board at NSA office

8. Appeals & Grievance Handling

8.1 Appeals Submission

Athletes and coaches may file an appeal within 3 days of selection announcement with:

- Written complaint
- Supporting evidence
- Processing fee (refundable if appeal is upheld)

8.2 Appeals Committee

A separate **Appeals Committee**, independent of the Selection Committee, will:

- Review evidence within 7 days
- Conduct hearings if necessary
- Issue a written final decision

The decision of the Appeals Committee is final.

9. Ethical Standards & Integrity Safeguards

- No coach or official may solicit payment, favour, or influence for selection.
- Any breach of integrity will result in disciplinary action, including termination or suspension.
- Anonymous reporting mechanisms will be maintained.

10. Policy Review & Amendments

This policy shall be reviewed every **two years**, or earlier if:

- Required by international bodies
- Recommended by NSA General Assembly

• Significant procedural issues arise

Any amendments require formal approval by the NSA Executive Committee.

11. Implementation

This policy comes into effect immediately upon approval and supersedes all prior selection guidelines.
